

## Wacky Wednesday Creative Exercise #5

# Musical Expression

Kandinsky's "Improvisation" paintings were an attempt by the artist to visualize and compose diverse elements and color as if the piece were a musical composition. He often related specific line or color to a musical instrument or particular sound or melody.

For this assignment, students should choose a musical subject to inspire a creative artwork. Instrumental compositions are suggested, but not required. A composition, preferably non-representational, should be created while listening to the musical selection. (Please list the title of the musical piece on the back of the composition.)
